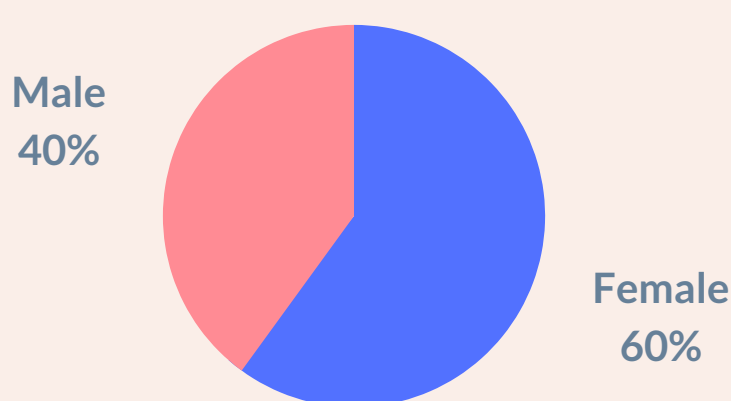


Bridge CRPD-SDGs Training of Trainers

GENDER EQUALITY

Over 60% of the participants are female

84% are from the most under-represented groups
